 What is your first thought when you hear the words Ten Commandments?

Exodus 19:3-6

- God loved us first. v. 4b...and brought you to myself.
- God invites us to love Him back- v. 5a "Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant..."
 - What is God's covenant that He wanted them to keep? How were they to keep it? What does this tell us about how we are to treat God's commands?
 - Matthew 22:35-40
 - What does it mean that they are His possession? Isn't everyone His? So what is the difference?
- God reveals His love through us- v. 6a "you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'"
 - Matt. 5:16

- No one will love you like God can!
- Love is anchored in God. (1 John 4:8b)
- God's love has boundaries. (1 John 5:3)
 - A fence provides you with two things: Freedom and Protection
