Matthew 5:10

Persecution - mistreatment; inflicting of suffering/fear, harassment, exclusion, imprisonment, torture, or death.

REASONS FOR PERSECUTION "because they live for God"

Because of the Lord we Love (John 15:18)

Because of the Lives we Live (2 Timothy 3:12; John 15:19)

RESPONSE TO PERSECUTION

First Instinct: React Defensively

New Posture: Embrace Grace "God BLESSES those who are persecuted"

- Guard against HATE (Matthew 5:43-44)
- Guard against REVENGE
- Guard against COMPROMISE (Matthew 5:48)

RESULTS OF PERSECUTION "for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs"

Acts 4:32-33; Acts 20:24
