



The Cross of Christ Ministries, Nigeria


The Cross of Christ Ministries is a multidimensional, Bible-based ministry committed to the spiritual, emotional, and physical well-being of those in Akute, Nigeria. They share Christ's boundless love through programs and ministries, including a hospital, worship center, and an orphanage.

The Cross of Christ Orphanage serves the most vulnerable children in Nigeria. They build families for children in need, help them shape their own future, and share in the development of their communities. The orphanage provides shelter to orphaned children, and also works for their education and welfare.

Most of the staff are volunteers who help free of cost. The ministry is only possible through the financial sacrifice and generosity of our donors.

The Cross of Christ Healthcare exists to provide accessible, high-quality, comprehensive primary healthcare services. They are able to save lives through access to essential healthcare. The elevated mortality rates and the lack of available resources makes the healthcare system in Nigeria one of global concern. CCH cares for the whole person, offering an array of coordinated services to improve overall well-being and life circumstances.

The Cross of Christ Worship Center offers weekly worship services and special programs that include outreaches and prayer vigils. The center is an active participant in the local community, working to strengthen families and heal broken homes.


The Bread of Life Church, Ukraine

The Bread of Life church was founded in 2010 and is based in the city of Poltava in eastern Ukraine, and before the beginning of the war, we welcomed over 350 people each week. The church is the base for many programs.

A place of hope and healing, we view it as God's instrument to bring life, light, and change to the world. In response to the tremendous needs around us, we started programs to serve the people of our city, bringing hope and restoration to a region of Ukraine torn apart by war – refugee relief programs, hunger and homelessness relief programs, a drug and alcohol rehabilitation center, a school, summer camps, and the Night in Bethlehem production.

When the war began in Ukraine, we took our 4 children to safety in California and began to travel to Ukraine from the USA. We prayed, asking God to lead us in what we should do: should we stay in the United States or go back to Ukraine? As time passed, we sensed God leading us back to Ukraine to continue our work there.

Our work in Ukraine would not be possible without the amazing people of Poltava and our generous partners all over the world. Thank you for your support. May the Lord bless you!

Charles and Kehinde Moodie left New York in July 2012 with their two sons, Joshua and Josiah, to minister in the Englewood neighborhood of Chicago. Englewood is known for it's violence, drugs, and deep urban poverty - it is listed as one of the worst crime areas in the country. This is a community where babies die at four times the national rate and high school is the exception rather than the rule. The Moodies left New York with a call so loud it was deafening. Together with Chris and Monica DeLaurentis, they are reaching Englewood for Christ.






PROJECTS


URBANA MIDDLE SCHOOL

For a number of years Stone Creek Church has had an ongoing relationship with Urbana Middle School, and we have been able to assist them in various different ways. UMS is a vibrant and lively school. It is home to many wonderful hard-working teachers and support staff and has many brilliant students. One of the most recent projects we've supported this year is the remodel of the teachers lounge. We found out that it was in desperate need of updating in order to create a workable space that staff could use and enjoy, so we decided to sponsor the whole remodel.

This was just one way we as a community could show teachers and staff that we value and appreciate them. The space was redesigned and put together by an amazing team from our church family and all the redecoration and new furniture was paid for from our Kingdom Builders fund.

EL ROI HOUSE

In 2009, the ministry of YoungLives began reaching teen moms and their children in Champaign County. It quickly became evident that these young moms were struggling to find safe, stable, and sustainable housing for them and their children. In 2022 through partnership with Stone Creek, YoungLives was able to launch their first home of young moms 16-22 years old who would otherwise be homeless. While with us the moms and children are placed with a house mom who helps support them and we also provide a wealth of support including individual

growth plans, healthy routines, parenting classes, financial literacy courses, individual case worker support, and professional counseling.

They are also be poured into spiritually through Christian mentorship, Bible studies, Champaign County YoungLives, and local churches.

Thanks to the ongoing support and generosity of Stone Creek together with YoungLives. We have been able to make an incredible difference in the lives of these moms and children.
